Sick/Accident Insurance Cover

This insurance has been developed to provide outside working hours sick and accident insurance cover. The Union can negotiate the cost and coverage of this insurance to Enterprise Bargaining Agreements with employers (See your Organiser). Cover is also available for individual members and/or their families at a very competitive rate. *(conditions apply)*.

Free Wills

Contact the Union office in regard to having a standard Will prepared free of charge for financial members *(conditions apply)*.

Funeral Benefits Fund

The families of financial Union members are entitled to funeral costs of up to \$5000. *(conditions apply)*.

Journey Accident Cover

Financial members are insured travelling to and from work for a maximum of \$1,200.00 per week with a \$5000 permanent disability/death cover at no extra cost. If an injury occurs, see your doctor as soon as possible, get a medical certificate and contact the Union immediately. *(conditions apply)*.

(Exclusion: no benefit if Third Party or Personal Insurance pays out).

Apprentices and Trainees

Anyone can join a Union - including apprentices and trainees. You have the same rights as other workers to a safe and healthy working environment, decent pay and conditions. There are no joining fees for apprentices and trainees and reduced pay rates apply.

Conditions of Application

MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS: I hereby make application to become a member of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union, Construction and General Division, South Australian Divisional Branch, and if admitted, agree to conform to the Rules of the Union.

NOTE: Written notice of resignation must be given in accordance with the Act.

DIRECT DEBIT REQUEST (SERVICE AGREEMENT):

- Debit will be on the 16th of each month (or next available day)
- The Member will be advised 14 days in advance of any changes to the Direct Debit arrangements
- For all matters relating to the Direct Debit arrangements, the Customer will need to contact the CFMEU via written correspondence or phone call and allow (1) one week for the amendments to take effect.
- The Member should be aware that:
 - Direct Debiting through BECS is not available on all accounts
 - Account details should be checked against a recent statement from your financial institution. If you are in any doubt, you should check with your financial institution before completing the drawing authority.
- It is your responsibility to ensure sufficient cleared funds are in the nominated account when the payments are to be drawn
- If the due date for payments falls on a non-working day or public holiday, the payment will be processed on the next working day. If the member is in doubt, refer to Point 3 for further clarifications.
- For returned unpaid transactions, the following procedures or policy will apply:
 - The Member will be notified in writing when this occurs and his/her membership will be debited with the agreed amount.

Fees and charges

All bank charges incurred will be debited to members' membership account.
